This is how we worked out your tax code:

We turn £9440 into a tax code of 944L. DWP (ESA) will use this code when they pay you. We tell DWP (ESA) your tax code but we do not tell them how we worked it out. If you think this is wrong or your circumstances have changed and you think it could affect the tax you pay, please tell us.

Notes

- 1 Nearly everyone who lives in the UK receives a Personal Allowance. This is income you can earn or receive each year tax-free. The amount you get depends on your circumstances. This tax year you are entitled to Personal Allowance of £9440.00. For more information go to www.hmrc.gov.uk/incometax
- 2 If your Employment and Support Allowance for the year is more than £9440, tax will be due as follows:
 - at 20% on the first £32010
 - at 40% on income between £32011 and £150000
 - at 45% on anything over £150000
