The National Council for Vocational Qualifications (NCVQ) has published the following guide to give a broad indication of the levels within its framework of qualifications.

National Vocational Qualifications (NVQs)

Levels apply to the overall qualification only.

Level 1 – Competence in the performance of a range of varied work activities, most of which may be routine and predictable.

Level 2 – Competence in a significant range of varied work activities, performed in a variety of contexts. Some of the activities are complex or non-routine, and there is some individual responsibility or autonomy. Collaboration with others, perhaps through membership of a work-group or team, may often be a requirement.

Level 3 – Competence in a broad range of varied work activities performed in a wide variety of contexts and most of which are complex and non-routine. There is considerable responsibility and autonomy and control or guidance of others is often required.

Level 4 – Competence in a broad range of complex, technical or professional work activities performed in a wide variety of contexts and with a substantial degree of personal responsibility and autonomy. Responsibility for the work of others and the allocation of resources is often present.

Level 5 – Competence which involves the application of a significant range of fundamental principles and complex techniques across a wide and often unpredictable variety of contexts. Very substantial personal autonomy and often significant responsibility for the work of others and for the allocation of significant resources feature strongly, as do personal accountabilities for analysis and diagnosis, design, planning, execution and evaluation.

There is no grading of achievement in NVQs, either for units or for the overall qualification.

General National Vocational Qualifications (GNVQs)

Levels apply to the individual units as well as to the overall qualification.

Foundation – GNVOs at Foundation level are designed to be of comparable standard in their demand and coverage to four GCSEs at grades D–G.

Intermediate – GNVOs at Intermediate level are designed to be of comparable standard in their demand and coverage to four GCSEs at grades A–C.

Advanced – GNVOs at Advanced level are designed to be of comparable standard in their demand and coverage to two GCE A levels or four A/S levels. Each GNVO unit at Advanced level is equivalent in demand and coverage to one-sixth of an A level qualification or one-third of an A/S level qualification.

A GNVQ may be graded overall at Merit or Distinction level, but the units themselves are not graded.

More information on the NCVO framework of qualifications and the requirements of particular NVOs and GNVOs is available from BTEC on request. In addition, information on all units may be found in the NCVO National Database of Vocational Qualifications. The reference code in that database for these units is shown on this Certificate of Unit Credit against the title of the unit.
